Battle of the Books. Mrs. Moses, school librarian. This Battle is a literary competition open to 3, 4th 5th grade students. Students commit to reading at least 3 of the chosen 13 books for this competition. Students decided to enter the battle, agree to reading 3 books and then students are put on team of 4. The Battle will officially start on Feb 1st. May 3rd is the Battle day. Registration forms just coming out now. Teams will be made up with kids from each grade. Mrs. Moses has been going around to each classroom to explain about this program to each classroom. Students sign a contract to guarantee they will read the books. Mrs. Moses chose the books to get diverse group of options. Some are linked to series, some are non-fiction etc. The Battle takes place during the school day. 8 Fridays in the morning meeting blocks 9-9:30. During the 8 sessions, practicing team work, team name, team logo, etc. The team building exercises to build up to the battle. Each team will have a coach who is a staff member in the school. There are some catches in place to insure students are reading the books so they don't have to fall behind. Reading does not have to be independent- students can read with parents or audio books. etc. The Battle will work like a quiz show. Trivia questions based on the books. Points for each correct answer. They have to have correct title and author of the books to get the points. Battle day is a fun day but very stressful because kids want to do well. Final battle might be in front of 2, 3, 4, and 5th grade. Planning is still happening. \$10 donations are being accepted. Battle participants have snacks on battle day. Small prize for the winner.
